Clothing

- Layered clothing

- Comfortable shoes or hiking boots
- Waterproof boots or boat shoes
- Sleepwear

Fishing Gear

- Fishing rods and reels
- Tackle and lures
- Jigs and soft plastics
- Pike leaders
- Pliers or hook remover
- Extra fishing line
- Tackle box
- Fish finder (optional)

Personal Items

- Toiletries
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Shampoo and Soap
- Towels and wash cloths
- Prescription medications
- Personal first aid items
- Headlamp or flashlight
- Phone charger

Bug & Sun Protection

- Insect repellent
- Bug jacket or bug hat
- Sunscreen
- Sun hat
- Sunglasses
- Lip balm

Food & Drinks

- Groceries for your stay
- Snacks for the boat
- Coffee (*percolator*) or tea
- Cooking essentials (oil, spices, etc.)
- Fryer oil
- Paper towels
- Beverages
- Cooler for transporting food
- Water

- Camera or binoculars
- Deck of cards or games
- Books
- Folding chair
- Portable speaker
- Small daypack
- Sleeping bag
